Certification

To aid our members in obtaining certification, the PMI Willamette Valley Chapter offers preparatory classes for the CAPM and PMP certifications several times per year. We schedule the time and location of courses throughout our chapter area to make it easy for our members to integrate certification preparation into their busy schedules. Our teaching environments are selected with learning and safety in mind. The chapter also works with government organizations, businesses and universities to cosponsor selected certification programs.

Our instructors are PMI members and certified professionals with extensive real-world project management experience, as well as academic training credentials. The classroom materials are provided by Velociteach, a Registered Education Provider, and are based on the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) Guide and the PMI Exam Content Outline.
